State of North Carolina Nash County August Term 1797

The Petition of John Glover Guardian &c of Wm. Glover, Nancy Glover, Mary Glover, Becky Glover & Benjamin Glover Humbly Showeth that he and his wards abovementioned are Children of Thomas Glover who departed this life sometime in the year one Thousand seven hundred & ninety one Intestate. That John Pritchett took out Letters of Administration upon his Estate in this Worshipful Court at term 179 that your Petitioner was appointed Guardian to the said Wm. Nancy Mary Becky and Benjamin in this Worshipful Court at term 179 . Your Petitioner further says that his said father died Seized & possessed of Considerable val. & personal Estate consisting of horses Cattle Hogs & Stock of all kinds, furniture money &c &c. That he y'r Petitioner has never received any part of the property due to his aforesaid Wards from the Estate of their said father. That the said Pritchett has hitherto refused to come to any Settlements with him In consideration whereof & to the End that the said Pritchett Ad'm &c may on his corporal oath true & perfect answer made to all the promises but particularly whether he did not Administer Whether y'r Petitioner was not appointed Guardian as aforesaid. Whether he has ever come to settlement with your Petitioner whether application has not been frequently [page break] made to him by your Petitioner – of what Estate did y'r Petitioner's father die seized and possessed of – and what has he done with it & that he may particularly set forth all the circumstances relating to the said estate of what it consisted of & what has he done with it. May it please y'r Worship to grant y'r Writ of Sg'n [signature?] to the said John Pritchett admin &c directed in order that Justice may be done to y'r Petitioner Guardian &c in such manner as to y'r Worship may seem meet & prayer & Will Ever pray &c

The Answer of John Pritchett to the petition exhibited by John Glover Guardian of Wm. Glover Nancy Glover Mary Glover Becky Glover & Benjamin Glover.

This Defendant saving answering to himself now & at all times hereafter all & all manner of exceptions to the many insufficiencies false allegations & errors in This said Petition unturned for answer thereunto in so much thereof as he is advised it is necessary for him to answer answereth & saith

That he admits that Thomas Glover departed this life Intestate on or about the time mentioned in the said Petition that he left the Children Herein named and that the Petitioner John Glover was appointed Guardian to the same –

This Defendant also admits that at the request and solicitations of the widow of the said Decedent who herself was unable to give Security be qualified as administrator to the said Thomas deceased –

He further admits he died seized & possessed of some personal Estate as may now fully appear by an Inventory returned to this Worshipfull Court but denies it was considerable or that mony composed any part of the same as set forth in the said Petition –

This Defendant further saith that the said Thomas died considerably indebted & that he has expended a great part the said estate in discharging the said Debts - - - And that among them he died Indebted to a Copartnership firm by the name of James Renaldson & Co due by Bond bearing Date the 1st May 1775 & payable the 1st of June following for £22⁹/₂ Virginia Mony which Bond This Defendant has now in his possession ready to be produced to this Worshipful Court –

This Defendant admits that the said Bond has not been discharged & paid off by him but that long since to wit in the life time of the said Thomas Glover & from his own mouth who often mentioned and acknowledged the justness of the said debt to this Defendant he had knowledge of the same and that since his Administration as aforesaid this Defenant by his Engagement & undertakings has made himself liable for the payment of the same –

This Defendant admits that applications have been made for a settlement of his administration and this Defendant does expressly say that he answered these applications by saying that he willing to settle provided this bond before mentioned was discharged, but knowing that he was responsible for the time he deemed it improper to deliver this estate out of his hands.

This Def. Further saith that in all things he has pursued the duties of an administrator as far as far as he was capable and prays to be hence dismissed with his reasonable costs & charges allowed him

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we John Glover Joab Tucker & Daniel Warren are held and firmly bound unto Hansom Powell Denton Mann & Lewis Hines Esquires, and the rest of the Justices assigned to keep the peace for Nash county, in the just and full sum of one hundred pounds, current money of the said state to be paid to the said Justices as aforesaid.

Their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns: To the which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and every of us, our, and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, Sealed with our seals, and dated this 14th day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety-seven

Whereas the above bounden John Glover hath been this day, by the worshipful court of said county, appointed Guardian to Benj. Glover orphan of Thomas Glover deceased: Now the Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the said John Glover Guardian as aforesaid shall well and truly discharge his guardianship, by taking care of and improving all the estate belonging to the said orphan; and shall also settle his guardianship accounts with the court of said county as is required by law; and that he will deliver up to the said Benj. Glover orphan as aforesaid, when he shall attain lawful age, all such estate as he ought of right to be possessed of, or sooner if required, agreeable to the true intent and meaning of the act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided; then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
